* The "stillness" of faith *[rest]* and the "simplicity" *[absoluteness]* of faith are two revelations that each and every one of my children must seek.

"stillness" - remaining in place or at rest; free from sound or noise [in this case, the "noisy distractions" of the world]; free from turbulence or commotion; peaceful; tranquil; calm;

"simplicity" - freedom from complexity, intricacy, or division into parts; freedom from deceit or guile;
