EXHORTATIONS FROM THE FATHER

["Reflections" Of The Father's Heart]

[March 20th]

JESUS:

* In the same way that I took upon myself the sins of mankind [the fullness of the spiritual death that entered into the earth at the Fall] past, present and future at the Cross [and beyond] - in order to COMPLETELY redeem mankind, the Enemy will SURELY bear, "in great torment", every last transgression [crime] that he has committed against mankind - from the Fall and throughout the centuries. "torment" - to afflict with great bodily or mental suffering and pain; to worry or annoy excessively; to afflict or harass - as by incessant repetition of vexations or annoyance;

"transgression" - to pass over or go beyond (a limit, boundary, etc.) to go beyond the limits imposed by (a law, command, etc.); violate; infringe; breach;

Latin: "transgressio" - a stepping across;

"violate" - to break, infringe, or transgress (a law, rule, agreement, promise, instructions, etc; to break in upon or disturb; interfere with; to break through or pass by force or without right; to treat irreverently or disrespectfully; desecrate; profane;
