* Righteous indignation and unrighteous indignation are two entirely different matters. Righteous indignation is a "spiritual *[holy and righteously motivated]* reaction" *[in the power and unction of My Spirit]* to something said or done that does not line up with a revelation of My Word/Will - while unrighteous indignation ALWAYS takes offense at *[finds fault with]* someone or something that does not line up with "their" agenda.
