EXHORTATIONS FROM THE FATHER

["Reflections" Of The Father's Heart]

August 25th

* The "maintaining" of a sin-consciousness [condemnation for "past" mistakes, fear, unworthiness etc.] causes one to draw back and fear [pull away from Me] causing great difficulty for that one to receive from Me that which is ALREADY theirs.

The maintaining of a righteousness-consciousness causes one to draw near to Me in a supernatural boldness for they have entered in *[through divine revelation]* to a knowledge of who they truly are IN Christ.

"sin-consciousness" - any belief or mind-set that constitutes one "believing" that that which they have actually been redeemed from is still to be in force in their life - through an adherence to "sense-knowledge" [Romans 8:1-2 KJV];

"righteousness" - manifests in the "ability" [in. and through. Christ and His "finished work"] to stand in God's Presence [or, for that matter, in the presence of Satan and his forces] without the sense of guilt, condemnation, or inferiority [unworthiness];

"righteousness-consciousness" - a continual awareness through revelation of who we "actually" are in Christ;
