MEDITATIONS ON THE TRUE CHRISTIAN LIFE

...."This book of the law [the Word of God] shall not depart from [always be in] your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful [take heed] to do according to all that is written in it; for THEN you will make your way prosperous, and THEN you will have success".... Joshua 1:8 NASB

January 10th

*"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen".... Hebrews 11:1.

Faith deals with the reality of "unseen things" that are not yet physically possessed. It does not need the impetus of excitement or sensation to push it onward because it wholly relies on what God is and what God has said. It does not depend on "appearances" and "feelings". The entire inner being of a "faith-man" enters into what God is, and their character and life are so influenced by what God has said that they live and act in a realm of "invisible certainties".

...."Therefore, we consider and look not to the things that are seen [the lower reality - that which is real to the five physical senses] but to the things that are unseen [through faith in the higher Reality of God's Word]; for the things that are visible are temporal (brief and fleeting) [subject to change], but the things that are invisible are deathless and everlasting [Eternal]".... 2 Corinthians 4:18 The Amplified Translation
