## February 27th

\* The flesh does not willingly desire to "die" (be crucified), to be restricted, or to be in subjection, or, of its own accord, be tamed, but the spirit of a man is eager to abide in the death of the Cross, resists sensuality, seeks to be subjected, and does not desire to exercise "personal liberty", loves to be held under discipline, and has no desire but to live, to abide, and be always under God and His Word, and for God's greatest purpose. It is always ready to be subject to any human being.

The flesh toils for its own advantage, and gives attention to what profit accrue to it from another, but the spirit takes thought rather, not of what is useful and advantageous to itself, but what profits many. The flesh gladly receives honour and reverence (the praises of men), but the spirit faithfully ascribes all honour and glory to God.
