* Sometimes we have thought that the gifts of the Spirit would inevitably bring unity. They undoubtedly would if they were "always" exercised in conjunction with the fruit of the Spirit. But the condition of one's spirit can so affect the manifestation and revelation of the Holy Spirit flowing through it, that even Christ can be preached in contention, and "tongues" can become "sounding brass". It is gifts and fruit working together in a sacred combination that alone will bring true unity.
