## May 11th

\* You may say: ever since I began to testify to Satan's defeat at Calvary, and to take authority over him and pray with a view to the "tearing down of his strongholds", he has been attacking me. That is because he sees the "prize" before you. He is attacking those who will judge the "fallen angels" if they obtain the prize of the Throne. Will you not then hold fast your crown? How are you to do it? Just with a steady, unswerving aim to be true to Christ, and to the light He has given you, at all cost to yourself.

Say to yourself, "The Lord is training me for the Throne." Say again and again: "Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world". "Hold fast that which thou hast that no man take thy crown." For every bit of the conflict there will be the gain. So Paul said, "The sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that shall be revealed in us."

...."we do not become discouraged (utterly spiritless, exhausted, and wearied out through fear). Though our outer man is [progressively] decaying and wasting away, yet our inner self is being [progressively] renewed day after day. For our light, momentary affliction (this slight distress of the passing hour) is ever more and more abundantly preparing and producing and achieving for us an everlasting weight of glory [beyond all measure, excessively surpassing all comparisons and all calculations, a vast and transcendent glory and blessedness never to cease!], since we consider and look not to the things that are seen [the lower reality - that which is real to the five physical senses] but to the things that are unseen [through faith in the higher Reality of God's Word]; for the things that are visible are temporal (brief and fleeting) [subject to change], but the things that are invisible are deathless and everlasting [Eternal]".... 2 Corinthians 4:18 The Amplified Translation
