* "Unlearning" is often the most important part of learning: wrong impressions and prejudices are obstacles to learning. Until these have been removed, the teacher labours in vain because he communicates knowledge only to the surface. Deep underneath the student is still guided by that which has become "second nature" to him.

Unless we are willing to unlearn we cannot learn of Christ fruitfully. Our hindrances to God's truth come from heredity, education, tradition, and our own thoughts about religion and the Bible. It is as one opens their heart to receive the incorruptible seed of God's anointed Word that revealed knowledge shall displace all "belief" that was rooted and grounded in a "sin-consciousness".
