* There is no passage that describes the Father's and Jesus' love attitude toward us more beautifully than Psalm 23:1 "Jehovah is my shepherd, I shall not want." This is perfect satisfaction.

This is finding the ultimate of living, "I shall not want."

It is beyond our understanding. It is in the realm of the spirit.

"He maketh me to lie down in green pastures."

This is where the luscious clover and tender grasses carpet the ground.

There is no effort required here to get enough.

He not only causes me to go into the green pastures, but He leads me beside the waters of gentle stillness.

Water and food are the requisites that sustain life.

He maketh me to lie down and rest in safety and quietness in the pastures of plenty. Near me is a babbling brook. Its living waters answer the cry of my heart.
