WHEN ONE ABIDES IN THE PLACE OF "FEARLESSNESS"

Words of prophecy:

* What one "truly" believes [desires] in their heart [either a revelation of My Will or something that has its origin in a lie] is what they will, ultimately, "act" upon [and proclaim]. In this hour, the true heart-position of each one of My children [wholly for Me - or a part still held back from Me] will become evident very quickly as I begin to "pour forth" My Spirit [through a holy remnant] to an ever increasing degree. For it is certain that great power [faith, love, righteousness, wisdom, light] and authority shall be found on the words that proceed forth from the heart that is wholly given to Me and, truly I say to you, many great things shall be accomplished [established] in this most glorious hour because of this!
