THE "ABSOLUTENESS" OF GOD

Words of Prophecy:

* I am Absolute and, therefore, if one is to fulfil their precious destiny, in Christ, they must come to "abide" [live and move and have their being immersed] in a "revelation" [the spiritual reality] of that Absoluteness.

"absoluteness" - free from imperfection; complete; perfect; not mixed or adulterated; pure; free from restriction or limitation; not limited in any way;

...."You, therefore, must be perfect [growing into complete maturity of godliness in mind and character, having reached the proper height of virtue and integrity], as your heavenly Father is perfect".... Matthew 5:48 The Amplified Translation

* *A life of "perfect obedience" is the ONLY way for one to be found "abiding" in My Absoluteness.*

"perfect obedience" - receiving a revelation of the Father's Will, and then carrying out that Will in the timing *[unction]* and power of the Holy Spirit - alone *[through the continual exercising of an absolute faith working through a perfect love];*

...."[Live] as children of obedience [to God]; do not conform yourselves to the evil desires [that governed you] in your former ignorance [when you did not know the requirements of the Gospel]. But as the One Who called you is holy, you yourselves also be holy in all your conduct and manner of living. For it is written, You shall be holy, for I am holy".... 1 Peter 1:14-16 The Amplified Translation How can one obey the Father on a consistent basis [come to "abide" in a perfect obedience] without continually acknowledging Him in ALL of their ways?

"acknowledge" - recognize the existence and authority of *[in this case, the true Nature and Character of the Father and His Word]*; to show or express appreciation or gratitude for;

...."Trust in the LORD with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight".... Proverbs 3:5-6 NASB
