THE OPERATION OF THE SPIRIT OF MAN

[PART 2 OF 5]

* According to the teaching of the Bible and the experience of believers, the human spirit can be said to comprise three parts; or, to put it another way, one can say it has three main functions. These are conscience, intuition and communion. The conscience is the discerning organ which distinguishes right and wrong; not, however, through the influence of knowledge stored in the mind but rather by a spontaneous "direct judgement". Often "reasoning" will justify things which our conscience judges. The work of the conscience is independent and direct; it does not bend to outside opinions. If man should do wrong in the sight of God it will raise its voice of conviction.
