* *.... "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness".... 1 John 1:9*

If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us".... In verse 10 the Word states that if we say that we have not sinned, and yet we are out of fellowship, we are liars. Broken fellowship can be restored the moment we confess our sins. God is faithful and forgives us. The broken fellowship is a thing of the past. As surely as you confess your sins He forgives. What He forgives He forgets. There is no memory of it. We should never remember it again. We should go on as though the fellowship had never been broken. We cannot have revivals with broken fellowship. We cannot have power with God or power with men if we have broken fellowship. It is very easy to have fellowship restored. It is very dangerous to live in darkness, for we know not whither we are going.
