God Has Revealed His Whole Heart And All His Will In The Word

* The Word then brings us into the closest and most intimate fellowship with God - unity of Will and Life. God has revealed His whole Heart and all His Will in the Word; in His principles and precepts He tells us what to do; In His Redemption and promises He tells us what He will do for us. As we accept that will and let it work out through us we will learn to know God in His working power. This should be our highest aim and experience in all our Bible study. The Word is meant to be the daily means of God revealing Himself to you and His way of having fellowship with you. We must be examples of people who know that the Word is NEVER separated from the Living God Himself. We should live as those to whom God in Heaven speaks every day and all day long.
