
MEDITATIONS ON THE TRUE CHRISTIAN LIFE

INTUITION

As the soul [mind, will, emotions] has its senses, so too has the spirit [intuition, communion, conscience]. The spirit is intimately related to the soul and yet is wholly unlike it. The soul possesses various senses but a spiritual man is able to detect another set of senses - lodged in the innermost part of his being which is radically dissimilar from his set of soulical senses. There in the uttermost recess he can rejoice, grieve, anticipate, love, fear, approve, condemn, decide, discern. These motions are sensed in the spirit and are quite distinct from those expressed by the soul through the body. We can learn about the sensing of the spirit and its many-sided character from the following verses:

From these many passages we can see readily that the spirit clearly senses and that such sensing is manifold. The Bible is not telling us here how our heart senses but rather how our *[recreated]* spirit does and it would appear that the sensing of the spirit is as inclusive as that of the soul. The spirit like the soul has its thoughts, feelings, and desires. But how we must learn to distinguish the spiritual from the soulical! We shall come to appreciate this difference if we are matured through the deeper work of the Cross and the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit enables our spirit [inner man] to know [through revelation]; our spirit instructs the mind to understand.
