THE SOULICAL AND THE SPIRITUAL

[part 5 of 6]

* *"The spiritual man judges [discerns] all things, but is himself to be judged by no one".... 1 Corinthians 2:15*

The spiritual man/woman is one whose spirit dominates and who has a highly sensitive intuition. It is qualified to perform its functions because its quietness is undisturbed by the mind, emotion and will of the soul. Why can the spirit man judge *[discern]* all matters? Because their intuition leans on the Holy Spirit for its knowledge. Why are they not judged *[appraised properly]*? Simply because no one knows how and what the Holy Spirit imparts to their intuition. If a believer's "knowledge" depends on their intellect, then besides those who are naturally talented no one can judge in all respects. Learning and worldly education would be indispensable, and such a learned one would also be judged by those who are as wise or even wiser than them, for they certainly could understand the train of their thought.

Spiritual knowledge, however, is base on the spirit's intuition. There is no limit to a Christians's knowledge if they are spiritual and possess a sensitive intuition. Their mind may be dull but the Holy Spirit is able to lead them into Spiritual Reality and their spirit *[inner man]* is able to enlighten their mind. The way the Spirit reveals Himself does indeed surpass the expectation of man.
