MEDITATIONS ON THE TRUE CHRISTIAN LIFE

...."This book of the law [the Word of God] shall not depart from [always be in] your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful [take heed] to do according to all that is written in it; for THEN you will make your way prosperous, and THEN you will have success".... *"The spirit of man is the lamp [light bulb] of the Lord".... Proverbs 20:27

God's aim is to fill the human [regenerated] spirit with Light; yet the believer's spirit is sometimes darkened. Why is this? It is because it has lost contact with the Holy Spirit. To perceive whether or not one's spirit is connected with the Holy Spirit, one need only notice if it is "shining". It thus is very necessary for us to maintain our spirit in a healthy quiet state so as to ensure its cooperation with the Holy Spirit. If it is disturbed by "external forces" it automatically is bereft of its power to cooperate with the Holy Spirit and is plunged into darkness [dullness].
