### "IRREPRESSIBLE JOY"

#### Words of Prophecy:

\* "Irrepressible joy" is one of the chief fruits of obedience [faith and love] - leading one into further obedience [in My Strength].

**"irrepressible"** - not capable of being repressed, controlled, or restrained [in this case, by the tactics of the Enemy];

.... "Do not be grieved, for the joy of the LORD is your strength"....  
Nehemiah 8:10 NASB

.... "the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control".... Galatians 5:22-23 NASB

Joy [divine strength and assurance] is the spontaneous fruit of one gaining a revelation of the Father's Will [Word] - for "revelation" [hearing and seeing] produces a deep and ongoing assurance [faith] in one's heart.

.... "So faith [comes] from hearing, and hearing by the [anointed] word of Christ".... Romans 10:17 NASB

.... "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see [both know and understand] God [and His highest purpose]".... Matthew 5:8 NASB

.... "Confidence [divine assurance] and strength [joy] flood the hearts of the lovers of God who live in awe of Him".... Proverbs 14:26 The Passion Translation
