THE SPEAKING OF "WHOLESOME" WORDS IMPARTS GRACE -BOTH TO OURSELVES AND TO OTHERS

Words of Prophecy:

* The speaking of "wholesome" words [words that are aligned with spiritual reality: the finished Work of My Dear Son, and all that is contained within the Covenant] impart Grace, not only to all those who cross their path but, also, to themselves. Whereas, "unwholesome" words [words that are in alignment with the law of sin and death] reinforce the lies of the Enemy and, therefore, allow him to perpetuate [perpetrate] his schemes against them.

...."Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such [a word] as is good for edification according to the need [of the moment,] so that it will give [impart] Grace to those who hear [including themselves]".... Ephesians 4:29 NASB

As long as someone is "sharing" out of their heart in the unction of the Holy Spirit *[Who is the Spirit of Truth and the Spirit of Love]* it is actually a very cleansing process - as the Father will replace any impurities *[grounds of fear and resentment, unforgiveness and bitterness etc.]* with His perfect Love. "Unwholesome" words spoken are words that have their origin in a spirit apart from the Holy Spirit, and are always self-serving and self-justifying - keeping that one in bondage to fear and darkness.

...."the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us".... Romans 5:5 NASB

.... "We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against

the true knowledge of God [and who we ALREADY are, in Christ], and we are taking every thought captive [through proclamation] to the obedience of Christ [a revelation of the Father's Will]".... 2 Corinthians 10:5 NASB
