## "Reflections Upon Reflections" [of The Father's Heart]

...."You, in Your great compassion, did not forsake them in the wilderness; The pillar of cloud did not leave them by day, to guide them on their way, or the pillar of fire by night, to light for them the way in which they were to go".... Nehemiah 9:19 NASB

#### March 5th

WE ARRIVE [IN OUR HEART] AT THE "PLACE CALLED DONE" BEFORE THE FULLNESS OF THE MANIFESTATION OF THAT WHICH WE ARE BELIEVING FOR

#### **Words of Prophecy:**

\* Abiding [dwelling spiritually] in "the place called Done" far transcends the need for one to affix themselves to a "natural" hope [through outward circumstances]. For in "the place called Done" revelation [divine light] abounds - and, thus, there is a continual release of an absolute faith in the "supernatural hope" [revelation] "actively" burning in one's heart.

"the place called Done" - is the place wherein one rests in the "finished" work of the Lord Jesus Christ [and the entire scope of the Father's Will - past, present and future] through the continual exercising of an absolute faith love, and obedience. It is the place wherein the Grace of God abounds towards one - empowering them perfectly in ALL things.

...."If because of the sabbath [rest], you turn your foot from doing your OWN pleasure on My holy day, and call the sabbath a delight, the holy day of the LORD honorable, and honor it, desisting from your OWN ways, from seeking your OWN pleasure and speaking your OWN word, THEN you will take delight in the LORD, and I will make you ride on the heights of the earth [Ephesians 2:6]".... ...."For we are God's [own] handiwork [His workmanship], recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined [planned beforehand] for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged

Most times, we arrive at the "place called Done" BEFORE the fullness of the manifestation of that which we are believing for - and, even if there are certain practical things that need to be addressed, it is certain that the victory is ALREADY being experienced by the heart that holds to a steadfast trust and faith [that is actually the place of abiding in spiritual reality - a place wherein "physical circumstances" and the lies of the Enemy have no influence whatsoever].

This whole matter of standing in faith comes down to making the "quality decision" to keep standing UNTIL the Father's perfect Will and highest purpose have manifested - NO MATTER HOW LONG THINGS MAY TAKE! When one reaches that point in their heart - having truly released the ENTIRE care of it on the Father it NEVER seems to be very long before the perfect manifestation unfolds before us.

...."And Jesus answered saying to them, "Have faith in God [lit. "have the God-kind of faith"]. "Truly I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says is going to happen [is ALREADY DONE - through the finished work of Christ], it will be [granted] him. Therefore I say to you, all things for which you pray and ask, believe that you have received them, and they will be [granted] you".... Mark 11:22-24 NASB

...."faith, if it does not have works (deeds and actions of obedience to back it up), by itself is destitute of power (inoperative, dead)".... James 2:17 The Amplified Translation

### **Prayer of Proclamation:**
