FAITH FINDS ITS SOLE ASSURANCE IN A REVELATION OF THE FATHER'S WILL [WORD]

Words of Prophecy:

* *It is ALWAYS a good thing in My sight for one to continue to pursue "peace" with all men - at least up to the point where they would have to "compromise" My Will [Word] to maintain what would THEN only amount to a "false peace" [and security] - something that is rampant in the church at large, through idolatry.*

"idolatry" - excessive or blind adoration - rooted in the worship of people and things [*ideals*] above God;

...."Repay no one evil for evil, but take thought for what is honest and proper and noble [aiming to be above reproach] in the sight of everyone. [Prov. 20:22.] If possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone".... Romans 12:17-18 The Amplified Translation

...."The kingdom of God isrighteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. For he who in this way serves Christ is acceptable to God and approved by men. So then we pursue the things which make for peace and the building up of one another".... Romans 14:17-19 NASB

Insecurity [*any ground of fear and mistrust in the heart that is maintained*] will lead to one continually reaching out after [*and maintaining - in their own strength and understanding*] a false security [*through soulish gratification*] - manifesting in a false peace. Faith finds its sole assurance [*security*] in a revelation of God's Word [*Will*] - an assurance and trust that continually

empowers one to rise above the physical circumstances with great peace and joy "abiding" in their heart.

....*"For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind".... 2 Timothy 1:7 KJV*

....*"for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit".... Romans 14:17 NASB*
