THERE IS ALWAYS AN IMPARTATION OF GRACE IN THE "INNER CHAMBER"

Words of prophecy:

* Spending time with Me daily in the "inner chamber" [the secret place of My Presence] is not just a good idea. Truly I say to you, it is the ONLY way that My children will overcome in this final hour - without exception!

...."One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek, inquire for, and [insistently] require: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord [in His presence] all the days of my life, to behold and gaze upon the beauty [the sweet attractiveness and the delightful loveliness] of the Lord and to meditate, consider, and inquire in His temple. [Ps. 16:11; 18:6; 65:4; Luke 2:37.] For in the day of trouble He will hide me in His shelter; in the secret place of His tent will He hide me; He will set me high upon a rock. And now shall my head be lifted up above my enemies round about me; in His tent I will offer sacrifices and shouting of joy; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the Lord. Hear, O Lord, when I cry aloud; have mercy and be gracious to me and answer me!"....Psalms 27:4-7 The Amplified Translation
