EVERY SITUATION WE ARE FACED WITH IS UNIQUE

Words of prophecy:

- * *There is no fear in a "holy" silence.*
- * *"Silence" can be a manifestation of My Wisdom - according to what "I" deem necessary [to speak or not to speak] in any given circumstance or situation.*

...."a man/woman of understanding keeps silent".... Proverbs 11:12 NASB

Sometimes we are called to "silence" [*particularly when in the presence of certain "spirits"*]. However, in some cases, the Lord will have us speak into a situation that will definitely cause a backlash. In that case, we are blessed [*divinely empowered*] because the "Spirit of Glory" rests upon us. Also, we have the protection provided for us by the precious [*and all-Powerful I might add*] Blood of Jesus.

The bottom line is this: every situation we are faced with is unique [*and has a distinct spiritual purpose in the sight of the Father*]. Therefore, we must discern the Lord's purpose in any given situation - whether we are to speak or not. The main thing for each one of us is to position ourselves, daily, in a place wherein we are sensitive to the still, small voice of the Holy Spirit. For if we do, it is certain that He will direct both our words and our actions with pin-point accuracy according to the Father's highest purpose - again, in any given situation we are faced with.

...."Blessed are those who have been persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are you when people

insult you and persecute you, and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward in heaven is great".... Matthew 5:10-12 NASB

*...."Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal among you, which comes upon you for your testing, as though some strange thing were happening to you; but to the degree that you share the sufferings of Christ, keep on rejoicing, so that also at the revelation of His glory you may rejoice with exultation.
