GET STILL IN YOUR HEART

Words of prophecy:

* Be "still" [in faith and peace] and KNOW that I am God [gain a deep, deep revelation of the spiritual reality of Who I truly am]!

"still" - remaining in place or at rest; motionless; free from sound or noise; free from turbulence or commotion;

...."Be still, and know that I [am] God".... Psalms 46:10 NASB

"If because of the sabbath [rest], you turn your foot from doing your OWN pleasure on My holy day, and call the sabbath a delight, the holy day of the LORD honorable, and honor it, desisting from your OWN ways, from seeking your OWN pleasure and speaking your OWN word, THEN you will take delight in the LORD, and I will make you ride on the heights of the earth [Ephesians 2:6]"....
