# DIVINE LOVE ALWAYS SEEKS THAT WHICH IS BEST FOR ANOTHER

### Words of prophecy:

\* One cannot serve Me AND themselves.

Love bears up under anything and everything that comes, is ever ready to believe the best of every person, its hopes are fadeless under all circumstances, and it endures everything [without weakening]. Love never fails [never fades out or becomes obsolete or comes to an end]".... 1 Corinthians 13:4-8a The Amplified Translation
