* How utterly undependable is man's "feeling". In case a Christian has sinned, how long will you tell him he must pray before he can receive forgivness? Let it be known that over two thousand years ago Christ had already borne your sins away: that you have already died in the death of Christ and, hence, you have already received forgiveness. All is well if you simply appropriate what Christ has already accomplished for you. If you wait for God to do a new thing in you, you may have to pray until Eternity comes. When we today ask God for forgiveness, we simply mean let that forgiveness that is already in Christ flow into us. We receive forgiveness because we believe God has already forgiven us in Christ. It does NOT depend on "feeling".
