Believers Are Winners

* Healing and victory are ours. They are ours without asking. All we need to do is to simply know it and praise Him for it.

Hebrews 4:14-16, "Having then a great high priest, who hath passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession."

Your old version reads, "profession."

We are to hold fast our confession. What is our confession? It is that we are New Creations, that sin has been put away, and that we are the Righteousness of God in Him.

We confess that "surely He has borne our sicknesses and carried our diseases."

Our confession is that He was stricken, smitten of God with our infirmities and weaknesses, and now by His stripes we are absolutely healed.

Sin and disease have been put away, and in the Name of Jesus we have dominion over Satan and the work of his hands.

In His Name we cast out demons. In His Name we lay hands on the sick and they do recover.

If we can cast out demons, we can also command the demon Disease to leave our bodies, for disease was brought there by a demon and is being developed by a demon.
