THE NAME OF JESUS IN THE GOSPELS

[part 1 of 5]

* AND she shall bring forth a Son, and thou shalt call His Name Jesus for it is He that shall save His people from their sins." Matthew 1:21. Little did Mary know the meaning of that angelic visit nor of the command that His Name shall be called Jesus.

That Name has grown until today it fills the whole earth. That Name means justice, love, righteousness, civilization, invention, discovery, art, literature, music, health, happiness, home; and, yet, in our study we have discovered that that Name means even more.
