* Many stubbornly hold to their "opinions" and, thus, they remain bound to sense-knowledge and perception - bound to the lower realm, and devoid of the revelation *[Grace]* necessary for them to enter into their true Kingdom-position and destiny, in Christ.

"stubbornness" - obstinate; fixed or set in purpose or opinion [in this case in opposition to the Will of God - both for themselves and others];

"opinion" - a belief or judgment that rests on grounds insufficient to produce complete certainty [in this case, a thought or mind-set rooted in the soul [mind, will emotions] - devoid of "revelation"]; a personal view, attitude, or appraisal; a conclusion or judgement held with confidence but falling short of positive [revelation] knowledge; a prevailing sentiment; an evaluation;

Latin: "opinare" - to think;

"sense knowledge" - that which is perceived by what one feels, hears, sees or thinks based on their outward circumstances; that which is perceived [and expressed] through the soul [mind, will, emotions] - apart from "revelation" [the Holy Spirit - Who is the Spirit of wisdom and revelation];
