* If one continually justifies *[holds on to]* their "victimization" then they remain a victim. If one chooses to continually acknowledge who they are IN Christ THEN it is certain that they will overcome in ALL things - and, in the process, walk in the place of continuous victory *[as a "victor" in Christ]*.

"victimization" - the act or fact of blaming others for the hardships one encounters in life: that school of thought says that victimization is an attitude: you may have no control over what happens to you, but you can control what you do with it [in this case, hold fast, in faith, to the absolute Truth of God's Word. Thus, allowing the revelation of the "Spiritual Reality" of who they are IN Christ enter into their spirit {inner man} - displacing the lies and actions {past and present} of the Enemy];

"victor" - a person who has overcome *[past tense]* or defeated *[past tense]* an adversary; conqueror;
