* An "anointing" needs "receivers" to effectually fulfil all that I purpose in any given moment *[environment]*. And it is certain that if the "soil" of one's heart is not "fertile" *[pure]* then SURELY the Enemy will hinder or block *[through unbelief, mistrust, pride etc.]* the reception of the anointing being released in that environment - even though many around them are blessed.

...."as for you, the anointing (the sacred appointment, the unction) which you received from Him abides [permanently] in you; [so] then you have no need that anyone should instruct you. But just as His anointing [Holy Spirit] teaches you concerning everything and is true and is no falsehood, so you must abide in (live in, never depart from) Him [being rooted in Him, knit to Him]".... 1 John 2:27 The Amplified Translation

...."I can do all things through Him [the Anointed One {Christ} and His Anointing {the Holy Spirit - Who is the Spirit of Christ}] Who [which] strengthens me".... Philippians 4:13 NASB

...."Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see [both know and understand] God".... Matthew 5:8 NASB

...."And they took offense at Him. But Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his hometown and in his own household." And He did not do many miracles there because of their unbelief".... Matthew 13:57-58 NASB
