\* Continual "immersion" in My Word leads, ultimately, to the total displacement of ALL that which is apart from Me in one's life - spirit, soul and body and financially [spirit of poverty, lack etc.].

"immerse" - to involve deeply, absorb;

"meditate" - Hebrew - "hagah" - to murmur; by implication, to ponder: imagine, mutter, roar [proclaim], speak, talk, utter;

"displacement" - to occupy the place of; replace; supplant;
