## [February 16th]

* Hatred in ANY of its forms [offense, unforgiveness, unwholesome words, self-exaltation etc.] both "defiles" and "blinds" one's spirit [inner man].
"hatred" - extreme aversion or hostility to someone or something; intense dislike contempt;
"defile" - to make foul or dirty; pollute; to tarnish or sully the brightness of [in this case, referring to the Enemy's attempt to afflict one's spirit {inner man}];
"Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you" Matthew 5:44 NASB
"Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give [impart] Grace to those who hear [including themselves]" Ephesians 4:29 NASB
"and while being reviled, He [Jesus] did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously" 1 Peter 2:23 NASB
"If you are reviled for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you" 1 Peter 4:14 NASB
