REFLECTIONS OF THE FATHER'S HEART

[Exhortations From The Father]

[February 24th]

* Tithing and sowing are NOT "obligatory". They are "revelatory" - based upon a revelation of My Heart [true Nature and Character] and Word.

"obligatory" - required as a matter of obligation; mandatory; imposing moral or legal obligation; binding;

"revelatory" - of, pertaining to, or having the characteristics of revelation [in this case, that which is born of a revelation of the Father's Heart and Covenant with His children];

...."the love [Wisdom, Truth, Grace] of God [the Father] has been poured out within our hearts [spirit, inner man] through the Holy Spirit [the Spirit of Love] who was given to us".... Romans 5:5 NASB

THEREFORE

...."Watch over your heart [spirit] with all diligence, for from it flow the springs of life [the forces of the Kingdom {Grace, Faith, Love, Truth, Righteousness and Wisdom}]".... Proverbs 4:23-24 NASB

"diligence" - constant and earnest effort to accomplish what is undertaken;

...."Will a man rob or defraud God? Yet you rob and defraud Me. But you say, In what way do we rob or defraud You? [You have withheld your] tithes and offerings. You are cursed with the curse, for you are robbing Me, even this whole nation".... Malachi 3:8-9 The Amplified Translation
