* "Killing time" and "redeeming the time" are two entirely different things. The expression "killing time" speaks of a state of passivity in one's heart that is ruled by fear - and is, thus, devoid of an "active" faith, love, obedience or divine patience.

While "redeeming" the time speaks of a fervency of heart that actively seeks and continually acts upon the revelation of My Will [*Word*] abiding in one's heart - through a perfect patience [*faith, love and obedience*].
