## [Exhortations From The Father]

## [June 22nd]

\* Praise in the midst of even the most adverse circumstances is Wisdom. For continual praise breaks one out of *[empowers one to "rise above"]* the "influence" *[control]* of the "second heaven". For praise "paralyzes" the "principalities" *[powers of darkness etc.]*.

**"paralyze"** - to bring to a condition of helpless stoppage, inactivity, or inability to act:;

"To me, the very least of all saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unfathomable riches of Christ, and to bring to light what is the administration of the mystery which for ages has been hidden in God who created all things; so that the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenly [places.] [This was] in accordance with the eternal purpose which He carried out in Christ Jesus our Lord".... ...."Praise Him for His mighty deeds; Praise Him according to His excellent greatness" [the abundance {magnificence} of His Greatness]".... Psalm 150:2 NASB
