* Interceding on one's "own terms" is not true intercession but, rather, an exercise in futility. For if one attempts to "intercede" for another in their "own" strength and understanding [through sense knowledge and perception rather than "revelation" {My Wisdom}] then it is certain that it will only serve to harden the heart of the one being interceded for - through the self-exaltive spirits [pride, fear etc.] being released through them [through their "soulish" intercession].

"sense knowledge" - that which is perceived by what one feels, hears, sees or thinks based on their outward circumstances; that which is perceived [and expressed] through the soul [mind, will, emotions] - apart from "revelation" [the Holy Spirit - Who is the Spirit of wisdom and revelation];

"perfect obedience" - receiving a revelation of the Father's Will, and then carrying out that Will in the timing [unction] and power of the Holy Spirit - alone [through the continual exercising of an absolute faith working through a perfect love];
