

# REFLECTIONS OF THE FATHER'S HEART

## [Exhortations From The Father]

[September 10th]

\* The forces of darkness [*fear, pride, control, self-righteousness in any of its forms, hatred etc.*] can be released through the human spirit WHEN one "allows" their mind to be continually "inundated" by the lying thoughts of the Evil One. For in allowing this "inundation" of their "thought-life" their spirit will become defiled [*infiltrated*] - and remain defiled by [*through*] the "words" that they give to those thoughts of darkness.

Because of these things, they [*the unrighteous words*] will they be released through that one's spirit - used by the Enemy to control the environment, with a view to warring against those found abiding [*operating*] in righteousness.

**"inundate"** - overwhelm; flood; bombard;

.... "*Let NO [not even one] unwholesome [unrighteously motivated, self-seeking] word proceed from your mouth, but ONLY such [a word] as is good for edification according to the need [of the moment,] so that it will give [impart] Grace [Life, Love, Truth, Wisdom, Righteousness etc.] to those who hear [including oneself]*".... Ephesians 4:29 NASB

.... "*Watch over your heart [spirit] with all diligence, for from it flow the springs of life [the forces of the Kingdom {Grace, Faith, Love, Truth, Righteousness and Wisdom}]*".... Proverbs 4:23-24 NASB

**"diligence"** - constant and earnest effort to accomplish what is undertaken;

.... "*We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the true knowledge of God [and who we ALREADY are, in Christ], and we are taking every thought captive [through proclamation] to the obedience of Christ [a revelation of the Father's Will]*".... 2 Corinthians 10:5 NASB

.... "*Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, [by] perfecting holiness in the fear [reverence]*

*of God [thus allowing Him {through the precious Blood and the power of His Word} to expel {displace} every last ground of fear {unrighteousness}] ".... 2
