* A natural [*soulical*] "brashness" is the spontaneous fruit of pride and arrogance - and is self-exaltive in nature.

Whereas, a "spiritual brashness and integrity" is the spontaneous fruit of an absolute irreverence for the Enemy and his schemes [*ways*] rooted in a deep love for Me - and for My Word.

"**brash**" - energetic or highly spirited, especially in an irreverent way;

"**integrity**" - wholeness; righteousness; uncorrupted virtue; honesty;

"**irreverence**" - lack of reverence or respect [*in this case, for the lies and schemes of the Enemy*];
