* Worry [anxiety] is "selfish" at its root [which is fear] and, therefore [if held to] "compels" one to depart from My Grace in order to "alleviate" the problem [in their own thinking {own understanding}].

"compel" - to force or drive, especially to a course of action; to bring about by force [in this case, the forces of darkness: pride, fear, unrighteousness etc.]; to overpower;

"alleviate" - to make easier to endure: lessen; relieve;
