* What is an "accusation"? Accusations are lies: a certain "projection" originating in the heart and mind [influenced from the "outside" {through sense knowledge and perception} - and remain rooted in one's innermost being] of the one who is used as a vessel of accusation.

Therefore, it is of the utmost importance when one is confronted with accusation to pray into *[over]* the "projection" *[ground]* - as revealed by the Holy Spirit - in order that the one held captive by a "spirit of accusation" might come to a knowledge *[revelation]* of the Truth.

"project" - to externalize and attribute something, such as an emotion, to someone or something else;

"accuse" - to find fault with;

Latin: "accusare" - to charge with a crime;

...."Accuse not".... Provervbs 30:10a Young's Literal Translation

...."Therefore you have no excuse or defense or justification, O man, whoever you are who judges and condemns another. For in posing as judge and passing sentence on another, you condemn yourself, because you who judge are habitually practicing the very same things [that you censure and denounce]. [But] we know that the judgment (adverse verdict, sentence) of God falls justly and in accordance with truth upon those who practice such things".... Romans 2:1-2 The Amplified Translation

...."Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you".... Matthew 5:44 NASB

...."and while being reviled, He [Jesus] did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously".... 1 Peter 2:23 NASB
