# NEVER LOSE SIGHT OF THE "SEEDS" YOU HAVE SOWN IN RIGHTEOUSNESS [OBEDIENCE]

### Words of prophecy:

\* The "seeds" [words and actions that are rooted and grounded in My Love] that one sows into the lives of those I have placed in their "sphere of existence" will set many on the "narrow path" to their precious destiny, in Christ, in this most critical and glorious hour. For, truly I say to you, "I" will see to it that the seeds they sowed [in obedience to the still, small voice of My Spirit] are brought to full fruition. They must simply begin to water those seeds they have sown with an absolute faith - "knowing" [maintaining a deep revelation of the spiritual reality] that they will come to "full fruition" - both now and throughout Eternity.

...."For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return there without watering the earth And making it bear and sprout, and furnishing seed to the sower and bread to the eater; So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth; It will not return to Me empty, without accomplishing what I desire, and without succeeding [in the matter] for which I sent it"....
