HIS SHEEP HEAR HIS VOICE

Words of prophecy:

* Faith comes by hearing. Fear also comes by hearing. Faith is maintained through a perfect and continual focus [in word and deed] on a revelation of My Word/Will. Fear is "maintained" in one's heart and mind through an "affixation" to the lies [and works, schemes] of the Enemy.

"affix" - to fasten, join, or attach to [in this case, one's focus, gaze];

...."faith comes by hearing, and the ear to hear by the [anointed] word [words] of God".... Romans 10:17 The Amplified Translation

....."And he [Jesus] said unto them, "Take heed what ye hear: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given".... Mark 4:24 KJV

...."If any man has ears to hear, let him be listening and let him perceive and comprehend. And He said to them, be careful what you are hearing. The measure [of thought and study] you give [to the truth you hear] will be the measure [of virtue and knowledge] that comes back to you - and more [besides] will be given to you who hear. For to him who has will more be given; and from him who has nothing, even what he has will be taken away [by force]".... Mark 4:23-25 The Amplified Translation

From this time forth. it is very important for each and every one of us, as God's children, to refrain from saying *[in any way]* that we have an "inability to hear" but, rather that, in Christ *[as one of His "sheep"]* we are divinely empowered to hear - and not only hear but hear with great clarity, from this time forth.

One of the great keys to hearing the still, small voice of the Holy Spirit is for us to be found focusing on the things that pertain to the establishment of the Glorious Church and the Kingdom - and our true identity, in Christ. In this way, we constantly keep our "filters" from being gummed up with the sludge *[in this case, darkness and distraction]* that the "world" produces.

...."let us run with patient endurance and steady and active persistence the appointed course of the race that is set before us, Looking away [from all that will distract] to Jesus, Who is the Leader and the Source of our faith [giving the first incentive for our belief] and is also its Finisher [bringing it to maturity and perfection]"....
