THE WORK OF THE CROSS IS A VERY PRECIOUS THING

Words of prophecy:

* Pride blinds - spiritual pride [self-righteousness] blinds absolutely.

"blind" - unable to see; sightless; unwilling or unable to perceive or understand *[in this case, the spiritual matters of the Kingdom]*;

...."Let them alone and disregard them; they are blind guides and teachers. And if a blind man leads a blind man, both will fall into a ditch".... Matthew 15:14 The Amplified Translation
