"MIGHTY THINGS COME FROM SMALL BEGINNINGS"

Words of prophecy:

- * Although the physical positioning [location residence] that I have many of My children in presently is "temporary" [as they are being prepared by My Spirit to move forth into the "fullness" of their precious destiny in Christ] that which I establish in their heart in this particular season will be Eternal. For in these days, it is of extreme importance for those who are truly seeking first the Kingdom to "allow" Me to establish both the proper [profitable] and necessary "patterns" [of obedience] in their daily life [in even the smallest details and habits] the fruit of this "establishing" being that when My blessings [which are superabundant] begin to "overtake" them in this most glorious hour they will already have been established in the place of "abiding" in spiritual reality [revelation, obedience] and, thus, they will not set their heart on the "increase" but, rather, they will simply enter into the fullness of all that I have planned for them with great peace and joy and My Grace [divine empowerment] will continually abound towards them right through to the end of the age.
- * Mighty things come from small beginnings.

...."He who is faithful in a very little thing is faithful also in much; and he who is unrighteous in a very little thing is unrighteous also in much".... Luke 16:10 NASB

...." If [when] riches increase, do not set your heart upon them".... Psalms 62:10 NASB

I have heard the word "Do not despise small beginnings" many times [both

personally and through others] over the years. A simple analogy would be the "mustard seed" which starts out so very small:

And He [Jesus] said, "How shall we picture the kingdom of God, or by what parable shall we present it? "It is like a mustard seed, which, when sown upon the soil, though it is smaller than all the seeds that are upon the soil, yet when it is sown, it grows up and becomes larger than all the garden plants and forms large branches; so that the birds of the air can nest under its shade".... Mark 4:30-32 NASB

In other words, what starts out "small" in the Kingdom will [through the continual nurturing {watering, exercising} of faith and love towards God and man], ultimately, produce superabundant fruit in that one's life and ministry - with great and far-reaching effects.

We [those who truly love God] are all being perfectly prepared for something [a Glorious Church] that does not yet exist fully in the physical realm [only in "pattern" or "glimpses" of the fullness of what will take place] - and, so, it is of the utmost importance that one just simply moves forward daily from "faith to faith" and obedience to obedience [revelation to revelation] "knowing" [having a deep revelation of the spiritual reality] that things will begin to "unfold" [according to the Father's perfect timing - and highest purpose in one's life and ministry] - then, ultimately, manifest fully in the physical realm.

I received a word from Him once many years ago and it was:

"I" must unfold ALL things"!

The Father was talking to me at the time about the establishment of the Glorious Church and His Kingdom in the final hour - and He was VERY serious. ALL things pertaining to the Church and the Kingdom must [and will] be done by "revelation" [a revelation of His Will "abiding" in the heart of individual believers] and, THEN, as each one goes forth in obedience to the revelation of the Father's Will in their heart [in the power of the Holy Spirit] a Glorious Church [and a "supernaturally" run divine government - which is a government of the Spirit not a government or organization established by man] will begin to rise up in the earth - a faithful and trustworthy people that will walk non-stop supernaturally right to the end of the age!
