WE MUST BE FOUND BASING OUR "REALITY" ON THAT WHICH THE FATHER AND JESUS HAVE SAID AND DONE

Words of prophecy:

JESUS:

* Tell My people, in this most critical hour, to base their "reality" upon that which I have said and done and NOT on that which the Evil One has said [*lies*] and done [*adverse circumstances - storms*].

...."Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine and acts on them, may be compared to a wise man who built his house on the rock. "And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and slammed against that house; and yet it did not fall, for it had been founded on the rock. *...."For our light, momentary affliction [this slight distress of the passing hour] is ever more and more abundantly preparing and producing and achieving for us an everlasting weight of glory [beyond all measure, excessively surpassing all comparisons and all calculations, a vast and transcendent glory and blessedness never to cease!]. Therefore, we consider and look not to the things that are seen [the lower reality - that which is real to the five physical senses] **but to the things that are unseen [through faith in the higher Reality of God's Word]; for the things that are visible are temporal (brief and fleeting) [subject to change], but the things that are invisible are deathless and everlasting***

.... "How great is Your goodness, which You have stored up for those who fear [reverence] You, which You have wrought for those who take refuge in You, Before the sons of men!".... Psalm 31:19 NASB

When one is confronted by any form of "turbulence" caused by the Enemy, it is of the utmost importance for them to stay in the "eye of the storm" *[the secret place of God's Refuge]* - knowing that the "storms" will cease and that a new day will, ultimately dawn *[a new day completely free from the present restraints that are upon them]*.

In light of all of these things, trust in the Father and His Word and the continual appropriation of Peace and divine Rest must be the order of the day - every day.
