REALIZATION FOLLOWS CONFESSION

[part 2 of 4]

* It is God who is at work with us, in us, and for us.

"How shall he not with him also freely give us all things?" (Romans 8:32).

You see, you are launching out into the realm of the impossible, just as Abraham did when he asked for a son. You're not asking for something you can do for yourself, but for something that is beyond reason. Then you refuse to take counsel with fear or to entertain a doubt.

The hardest battles I have ever fought have been along this line. The greatest battles I have ever won have been those that seemed the most impossible, where there was the greatest opposition, where reason was discredited by faith. I held fast to my confession, and the Word was made good.

Confess your dominion over disease in Jesus' name. Never be frightened by any condition, no matter how forbidding, how impossible, the case may be. It may be cancer, tuberculosis, or an accident in which death seems to be the master of the situation.

You never give in. You know that you and God are masters of the situation. You never for a moment lose your confession of your supremacy over the works of the Adversary. This disease, this calamity, is not of God. It has but one source—Satan.

In Jesus' name, you are master. You have taken Jesus' place; you are acting in His stead. You fearlessly take your position; confess your ability in Christ to

meet any emergency. Always remember that Jesus met defeat and conquered it. You are facing defeat everywhere as a master.
