THE INTEGRITY OF THE WORD

* THE integrity of the Word is the basis of faith.

The reason for unbelief and a faltering faith is a lack of assurance of the integrity of the promises in the Word. In Romans 10:8 it is called "the Word of faith."

God's Word gives birth to Faith: it is God's faith expressed.

Hebrews 11:3: "By faith we understand that the worlds have been framed by the word of God, so that what is seen hath not been made out of things which appear."

In other words, this universe of ours came into being fresh from the womb of our Creator.

You see, God and His Word are one.
