THE VALUE OF CONFESSION

[part 3 of 13]

* "And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony" (Revelation 12:11).

"The word" here is logos. They overcame the Adversary because of the blood of the Lamb, and the logos that was in their testimony. They rested on the integrity of the Word.

They dared to confess that what God said was true.

"Who was delivered up for our trespasses, and was raised for our justification" (Romans 4:25 asv).

"Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 5:1).

Then dare confess that this is true now.

Confess your righteousness in Christ.

We are now the righteousness of God in Christ.

We dare declare this before the world.

We dare confess that God Himself has become our Righteousness (Romans 3:26).

By the new birth and the Spirit, we have been made the very righteousness of God in Him. "Him who knew no sin he made to be sin on our behalf; that we might become the righteousness of God in him" (2 Corinthians 5:21 asv).

This is God's own declaration of what we are now; not what we want to be, but what God has made us to be.
